Athletics Carnival 2019

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

When:	Thursday 25 July 2019 (wet weather date Thursday 15 August 2019)
Who:	All students in Years 3-6 and Year 2 students turning 8 this year who wish to compete.
Where:	Dunbar Park, Marsfield
Events:	100m, 200m heats and finals and long jump will be held on Thursday 25 July at Dunbar Park. If your child wishes to compete in the 800m event, it will be held at 8.15am. Students will need to be transported to Dunbar Park by parents to compete in this event. To ensure the smooth running of the carnival at Dunbar Park high jump, discus and shot put events will be run on site at school during class time on Tuesday 30 July (wet weather date Tuesday 13 August). If your child wishes to compete in the high jump, a separate permission note must be completed.
Cost:	Cost of \$15.00 covers hire of the park, equipment, specialist sports instructors and transport. Please pay via the Make a Payment button on the website http://www.gladesvill-p.schools.nsw.edu.au or by cash or cheque (payable to Gladesville Public School). If you are unable to make a payment by the due date (5/7/19) please contact the office to arrange a payment plan or request to meet the principal to apply for student assistance.
Transport:	Students will need to be at school by 9.00am to travel to Dunbar Park by bus, leaving the school by 9.15am. Parents may take students home once the carnival has concluded and the supervising teacher has been informed, otherwise students will return to school by bus before 3.10pm. If your child is to be collected by another parent, a signed permission note must be given to the supervising teacher.
Supervision:	Gladesville Public School students will be supervised by members of staff from the school who have current training in emergency care.
What to wear:	Sports uniform or suitable sportswear in their house colours. No participant is permitted to run barefoot or in spikes.
