Spectators:	Parents are very welcome to attend and will need to pay a spectator's entry fee at the pool.			
	Please note also that there is limited parking in the area and it is timed.			
Races:	All heats will be timed finals, as race finals are not held. All races will be held in the 501			
	pool. To enter your child in a race, please visit the school's website and, using the code			
	cm5pp, select appropriate events. To allow the school time to organise events, online			
	selection and this permission note need to be completed and returned to the school by			
	Monday 4 February. Students returning the note after this time may not be able to			
	compete in the events that they have requested.			
0	Please note that students must compete in the age group that they are turning in 2019.
