The GPS Boys Soccer team performed exceptionally well in last week's State Knockout Finals at Valentine Park. They played magnificently in their semi-final against Tacking Point PS before conceding an unfortunate goal in the last minute of play to go down 2-1. While disappointed, the boys demonstrated great team spirit and fantastic sportsmanship and were able to lift and defeat Hillsborough PS 2-1 in the play-off for 3rd place. We sent two teams to the Sydney Final of the Milo T20 Cricket Cup last Wednesday where they had the chance to play a series of games against other Zone Champions.
