On Monday 14 November students from K-2 will have the opportunity to hear the school Bands perform and to participate in an interactive session conducted by our incredible Band Coordinator, Mr Gav. Student and Road Safety

We are extremely fortunate to have a number of parents volunteering to assist at our Kiss & Drop Zone each morning and afternoon. They do so purely to help our students arrive safely at school each day and also depart safely. The Kiss & Drop Zone has the potential to be incredibly dangerous when people are in a hurry and take risks. Please help us keep our students safe by following the guidelines and using the pedestrian crossings, even if there appears to be no traffic. Please also remember that if there are four cars lined up, drivers need to complete a loop around the block rather than idling near the RSL club.

We also have a number of students who are often left at school long after the bell. It is unsafe to leave students unattended for periods up to 45 minutes in the afternoon. If you know you will be late to collect your child, please make alternate arrangements so that your child can be supervised adequately. The Staff frequently have meetings after school and cannot be expected to supervise students after school.

Student Executive 2017

This week our Year 5 students are presenting speeches to their class outlining reasons why they believe they will be a good school leader in 2017. Following these speeches the Year 5 students will elect 10 boys and 10 girls to prepare short videos about their leadership capabilities. In the coming weeks all students in Years 2-5 plus staff and this year's student executive will vote to elect our Student Leaders for 2017.

Opal Transport Cards

Students who currently have an Opal card they use for transportation to school will be able to re-use the same card in 2017. Please keep this card safe over the holidays to re-use next year. Online Payments Through the School's Website

Many parents/carers are now using our On-line POP payment through our school website for amounts owing for students. Payments can be made on this by using a Visa, Mastercard or Debit card. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the school's website by selecting "\$ Make a Payment." When you access this, and make a payment, you must enter the following:

- The Student's name
- Student's class
- Student's Date of birth

(It is not necessary to enter the student registration number.)

These details must be entered **each** time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system. This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner. These details are not passed back to the school. For any enquiries regarding the Online Payment process, please contact the school office.

Tech Tips

"Creative Cloud for Students – News"

As part of the Department of Education enterprise agreement with Adobe, all public schools students are now licenced to install, free of charge, the latest Creative Cloud suite for their BYOD or home computer (Windows/OSX). Students will need to **update their licence annually** and will therefore be able to do this as long as they remain public school students. They will also be required to **create an Adobe ID account**, which for students under the age of 13, will require the permission and assistance of their parent/guardian. To assist with and better explain these changes, an **FAQ** has been developed and included at the OnTheHub store. Microsoft products are also available.
