# PSSA Champions

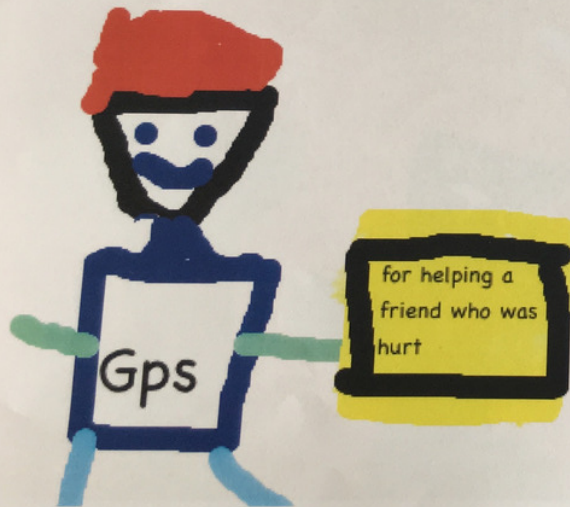

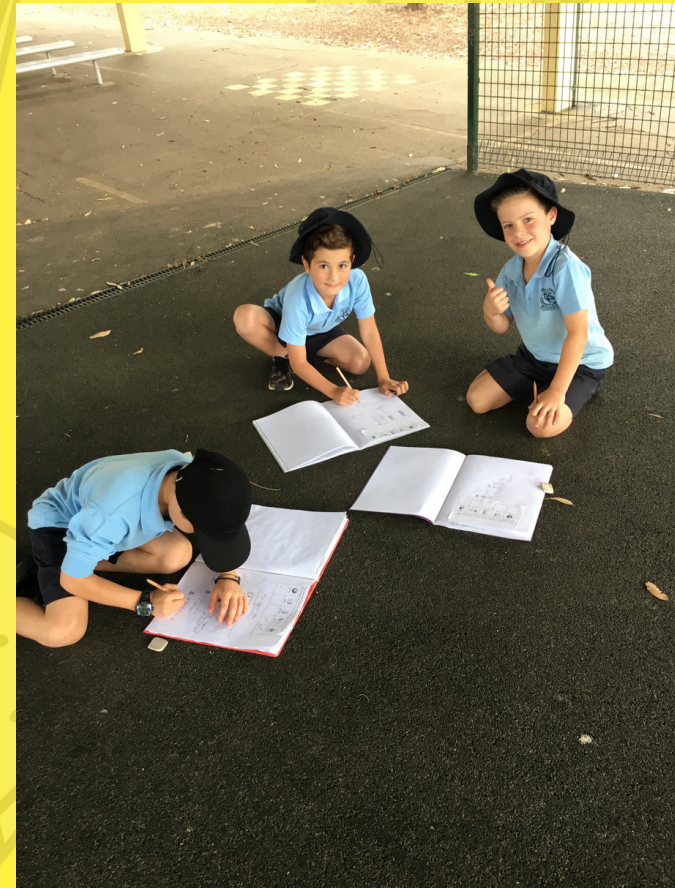
