# QLD/NSW border restrictions Public Health Alert-stay at home restrictions

New <u>stay at home restrictions</u> were released on Monday 29 March and will apply immediately to anyone who visited Greater Brisbane since Saturday 20 March regardless of their current location.

If a person has returned from Greater Brisbane, which includes Brisbane, Logan, Moreton Bay, Ipswich and Redland Local Government Areas since 20 March 2021 must comply with the <u>Stay at Home Order</u> consistent with those living in identified areas in QLD until 5 pm Thursday 1 April 2021. This means they cannot attend work or come to school for this period.

Non-essential travel to Brisbane is not advisable at this time.

In addition, a number of locations in NSW have been identified to be associated with a COVID-19 case. The full list of locations is available on the <u>NSW Health website</u> along with the instructions you will be required to follow if you visited any of these sites during the specified date and time.

This means:

- If a person has been to any of the **close contact locations** on the dates and during the times listed, they must get tested immediately and self-isolate for a period of 14 days from the time they attended the location. This means they will not be able to attend work or school for the full 14 day period.
- If a person has been to one of the **casual contact locations** on the dates and during the times listed, they must get tested and self-isolate until they receive a negative result. That means they cannot attend work or school until they receive confirmation of their negative result. Then they can return to their normal living arrangements.

Please monitor the <u>NSW Health website</u> for locations of concern over the coming days as changes may be made with new sites and locations added.

## **School Photos- Wednesday 31 March**

School photos will take place on Wednesday 31 March. Please ensure payment envelopes have been returned to school or brought to school on photo day. Sibling photo envelopes will be available to be collected by students **ONLY** from the front office. **Students need to wear their full summer uniform on photo day.** 

# Telstra upgrade/rollover

Telstra will be upgrading our system on Thursday 1 April at 8am. There will be a disruption of the internet for up to a maximum of 3 hours on that morning to allow for the upgrade to



be completed. Telephones will be operational during this time but we ask that only urgent matters are communicated during the upgrade.

## Easter Hat Parade-Thursday 1 April

If you will be attending the parade, it will be necessary for you to sign in and use the Service NSW COVID app located at the Trim Place gates from 2pm.



Please note the following restrictions that will be in place to comply with NSW Department of Education guidelines:

- only one person per K 2 child can attend the event
- parents who do not have children in K 2 will not be able to attend
- all parents attending must complete the mandatory two-part sign in process using the Service NSW COVID app and signing in at the tables located at the Trim place gates whereby you are agreeing to complying with COVID safe practices outlined on displayed posters
- social distancing of 1.5metres must be maintained at all times between adults
- all attendees must depart the school immediately after the event
- please do not gather in groups at entry or exit points or on the school site
- please do not attend if you are suffering from any cold or flu-like symptoms, regardless of how mild
- students in years 3-6 with K-2 siblings will not be dismissed until 3:10pm

# Intention to apply for Year 5 entry to an opportunity class in 2022

Opportunity classes cater for academically gifted and high potential students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. Successful students will usually have to leave their current school to enrol in a school with an opportunity class for Years 5 and 6.

Applications for opportunity class placement are considered mainly on the combined results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test and school assessments. Students who wish to be considered for opportunity class placement will sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on **Wednesday 21 July 2021**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2022, you need to apply between **Tuesday 20 April 2021** and **Friday 7 May 2021**. You will need to access the online application at: <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-5">https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-5</a>. You must **not** use the child's email address.



If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after **Tuesday 20 April 2021**.

You must submit only **ONE application** for each student. **THE SCHOOL CANNOT APPLY ON YOUR BEHALF.** 

#### Check-in Assessments Years 4 and 6

Year 4 and Year 6 students will participate in a reading and numeracy check-in assessment over Weeks 1 and 2. The check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment which supports schools to assess and monitor Years 4 and Year 6 student learning. The check-in assessments supplement our existing school assessments in identifying how students are performing in reading and numeracy. The results will be used formatively by the teachers as they will help to inform our next steps so that teaching and learning curriculum delivery is responsive to student needs.

#### **Term 2 Dates**

Students return to school on Tuesday 20 April. Monday 19 April is a Staff Development Day when teachers will be engaging in professional learning focused on explicit teaching in reading and behaviour support.

#### **Parent Teacher Interviews**

Information about upcoming parent teacher interviews was sent to the community yesterday via School Stream. Gladesville Public School invites parents to attend interviews with teachers as part of the Semester 1 reporting process. This year parent-teacher interviews will be held using the video conference platform, Zoom based on feedback from the parent/carer community last year and the Department's advice that schools should continue to consider the use of alternate technology platforms for parent/carer meetings. In the event you do not have access to technology, please contact the school or your child's teacher to organise another arrangement.

Bookings will be made online by going to <a href="https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/">https://www.schoolinterviews.com.au/</a> or via the link on the app. Use the code <a href="79g87">79g87</a> then enter your details, select the teachers you wish to see and select an appointment time. For those families with more than one student at the school, we recommend that you leave a minimum of 10 minutes between each appointment time. Once you have made your booking, a confirmation email will be sent immediately to your nominated email address. If you do not receive your email, please check your junk/spam folder and make sure your email address is correct. You may book or change your appointment up to 3.00pm Friday 23 April, when all bookings will be finalised. Please contact the school office if you need to access internet at school to complete a



booking.
