Supporting positive school attendance is a shared responsibility - everyone has a role. Parents and carers play an important role in helping to foster positive attendance at school by:

- working with the school to encourage and support regular attendance


Student Absences

When children attend school unwell, or become unwell whilst they are at school, parents/carers will be asked to collect them. Please understand that this is not just due to COVID-19 and the guidelines around cold and flu symptoms, but any type of illness that your child may present with.

Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, loss of taste, and loss of smell), even mild symptoms, should not be at school. We ask that you arrange for your child to have a COVID-19 test and send a copy of the results to the school email. Students and staff with flu like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school. We appreciate your ongoing support with this.

Enrolment: Kindergarten 2022

Families are starting to enrol via the online enrolment system for Kindergarten 2022. If you know families who may have children who will attend Gladesville Public School, please point them in the direction of our school website to complete the process online.





Assessments in Literacy and Numeracy

At Gladesville Public School, teachers use a wide range of tools to assess what students know, can do and understand in order to plan for future learning. Last week our Year 4 and Year 6 students participated in the Department of Education's Check in Assessments in reading and mathematics. For Years 3 and 5 students National Assessment Program in Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) online will commence in Week 4 and continue through Week 5. A timetable of assessment dates and times has been communicated to parents and carers. The assessments are a snapshot of students' performances at a given time and the results help teachers' plan subsequent teaching and learning programs. Thank you to Mrs Elsinga for coordinating the tests.

In addition, teachers gather data from daily activities, observations, and samples of learning to determine each student's level of understanding. A wide range of assessment data is used by teachers to inform future lesson plans as well as to make judgements for semester reports. These reports will be available for parents via the Parent Portal at the end of Term 2.

ANZAC Day

Our student leadership team led a moving Anzac Day service to commemorate the lives of Australians who died at war. Lexie and Charlie, our school captains, proudly represented Gladesville Public School at the Ryde Council Anzac Day Service.

FINAL REMINDER: Intention to apply for Year 5 Entry to an opportunity class in 2022

Opportunity classes cater for academically gifted and high potential students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. Successful students will usually have to leave their current school to enrol in a school with an opportunity class for Years 5 and 6. Applications for opportunity class placement are considered mainly on the combined results of the Opportunity Class Placement Test and school assessments. Students who wish to be considered for opportunity class placement will sit the Opportunity Class Placement Test on Wednesday 21 July 2021. If you would like to have your child considered for Year 5 opportunity class entry in 2022, you need to apply between Tuesday 20 April 2021 and Friday 7 May 2021. You will need to access the online application at:

You must not use the child's email address. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after Tuesday 20 April 2021. You must submit only ONE application for each student.
